Exotics Driver by Tour Edge Review

On a New Year’s golf trip to Orlando, I had the chance to play a Tour Edge Exotics driver. With a Tour Edge 16 degree already in my bag, I came with a predisposition toward the Tour Edge products. Having heard that the drivers were long, only added to my anticipation of playing the club carried by Tour players. Sure enough the driver filled its promise of more distance. The very traditional looking driver has a YS fifty gram shaft that reminded me of the Burner shafts. The sweet spot on the Exotics might be slightly smaller than the game improvement style drivers with massive heads, but flushly hit drives are rewarded with extra yards. I used it in a scramble so the advantage was extremely welcome. The Tour Edge line provides good quality at a value, and is certainly worth trying out. I recommend it for golfers with handicaps of 18 or less. –Ayce



Ayce’s Top 9 Golf Show Tips

Are you going to the golf show this weekend? If so, check out Ayce’s tips for having a more successful adventure. Why only 9, not 10? I don’t know so ask Ayce at the show!

1. Don’t come early. This advice may sound strange to many, but there is usually a line for the first hour just to get into the lobby of the building. Wait until the line has diminished, there will be plenty to see later.
2. Do go early for the shows as seating is limited. The popular shows (like trick shot artist Peter Johnke) will be standing room only for most viewers, but still worth seeing.
3. Make sure you are in the right Hall. There are two halls of shows so before you park be sure you are at the golf show.
4. Upon entering the hall go to your left. Most people are right handed and tend to go to the right and meander the aisles. Go left as the left side of the hall will be less crowded.
5. But, look for crowds. One of the best ways to find nice freebies and coupons is to look for a crowd.
6. Get coupons. Waggle is giving away a Chick-Fil-A coupon and a \$10 off coupon for a Waggle Golf Pass. Look for these kinds of gems (booth 442!)
7. Enter to win things. Lots of prizes are given out so register to win, somebody has to win might as well be you.
8. Negotiate for clubs. Remember that these shiny new sticks are last year’s models so make an offer. Comparison shop vendors as there will be many club merchants.
9. Take your time. It is too cold to play this weekend and there are no football games, so enjoy talking golf with your fellow addicts.
