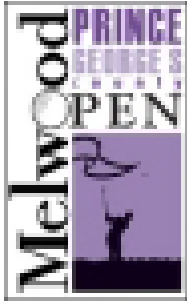


## Jeff Klauk Wins Melwood Open



After hanging around the top of the leader board all week, Jeff Klauk birdied the final hole to win the Melwood Prince Georges County Open on the Nationwide Tour this past weekend. The weather on the final day could not have been more perfect, but unfortunately the beach drew better crowds than this fantastic event. Organizers did an incredible job setting up and administering the event for the second year. Klauk took home \$117,00 for first and raised his total for the year to over \$221,000. The finish all but guarantees him a spot on the PGA Tour in 2009 based on top 25 earners. Klauk's father retired recently as superintendent at TPC Sawgrass, where Jeff grew up playing golf. Congratulations to Jeff Klauk and to the Melwood Prince Georges tournament committee, both big winners this week!

## The LPGA Is Up Next at Bulle Rock



Suzann Pettersen, defending champion of the McDonald's LPGA Championship, is set to return to Bulle Rock next week. Championship week will begin on Monday, June 2nd with the two-day LPGA Pro-Am, the LPGA Practice Round on Wednesday, June 4th, and Championship play on Thursday, June 5th through Sunday, June 8th. Pettersen will be joined by the top women golfers in the world, including Lorena Ochoa, Annika Sorenstam, Se Ri Pak, Christie Kerr, Morgan Pressel and Paula Creamer.

The 2008 Championship offers the potential for unparalleled competition as Pettersen stands as the #3 player in the world, third only behind Lorena Ochoa and Annika Sorenstam in the Rolex Rankings. She earned this position as a result of her triumphant 2007 season, which included 6 other Top-10 finishes, most notably winning the Michelob Ultra Open at Kingsmill and a T2 finish at the Kraft Nabisco Championship. ## AT&T National Report



Tuesday's Media day for the 2008 AT&T National Tournament hosted by Tiger Woods could not have enjoyed a more perfect day of weather. Let's hope the weather for the July 2-6 event at Congressional Country Club in Bethesda is not too oppressively hot! The entire sports media from the Golf Channel to Waggle.com was in attendance for a day of golf, lunch, and press conference with Tiger. The organizers did a remarkable job last year with only 100 plus days to pull off an excellent event, so expectations are justifiably high this year. The tournament will remain at Congressional in 2009, but the next two years are "up in the air" according to the tournament host. Speculation was rampant following an Monday Washington Post article about the 'new' Avenel, that an announcement to move there in 2010 might be forthcoming. The new TPC Potomac at Avenel Farms will reopen this November. When asked about the course Tiger said he plans to take a look at the redesigned track soon, just not this week. The main focus of questions centered around Tiger's health. He indicated he was "bored" with rehab, specifically riding a bike. While it sounded as though he is anxious to get to the US Open, he may not be as ready as the old Tiger. Or perhaps not as ready as #2 who pulled off THAT SHOT last Sunday to win. Plan to attend the AT&T National. The field looks awesome and you know there will be fireworks!
