### Pinehurst Trip Report by Lefty

The OBX IX trip took us to Pinehurst (yea, I realize this is not OBX) for a late spring golf excursion. A morning round at Independence Golf Club just south of Richmond was the Saturday morning play. This Tom Fazio design course was conceived as “Virginia’s Home for Golf” and I gotta say it is a rather nice track. The greens, fairways and tee boxes were all in great shape and the challenging holes will certainly have you using every club in the bag. From Richmond, we headed the 4 hours to Pinehurst and got to the house in time to see the Penguins drop game 5 but as anyone knows, in hockey anything is possible.

Early Sunday AM we were off for the 1st of two rounds at Foxfire Resort and Golf Club. The East course was played 1st and featured an opening par 5 with a steep drop off and lake lurking about 250 from the tee box. Not the opening shot anybody wants, especially yours truly after a few beverages on the ride down the prior night, but I managed to stumble around the lake and par #1. The rest of the round was uneventful and we were slightly disappointed to find the greens “furry” and the course generally not in “resort” shape. Alas, as we learned, during the off-season the courses gear down the maintenance end of things and let the greens grow somewhat to reduce the stress on them from the hot summer. Don’t get me wrong, the course was very playable but it just seemed that you couldn’t hit the putts hard enough to get it to the hole. The layout of this course (as well as the West track played in the PM) was definitely challenging, albeit it somewhat tricked up with several sloping fairways and elevation changes. I did notice what appeared to be a lot of debris around the clubhouse and large back deck from an apparent party the previous evening – perhaps THAT’s what Foxfire is famous for?

Monday took us to “The Pit” which I had heard about being a course that was reclaimed from an old gravel pit. And that it was – although don’t make the mistake that we did and play from the tips! At only 6200 or so yards, we figured it can’t be that tough but trust me it was! Many “chutes” and narrow fairways required accuracy off the tee. Once again, the greens were pretty furry and the conditions a little less than pristine but same as yesterday, we had a good time and would definitely return to play the Pit again! Oh, the post round beverages were ice cold and they had great shirts in the pro shop. After a couple of beverages, we had some time to kill so when in Pinehurst, you have to visit Pinehurst #2 and have a beverage. We took a seat at the bar adjacent to the 18th green and began the wagering. You know what I’m talking about - \$1 this guy misses this putt! Double or nothing he hits his approach in the sand, etc. A fun way to end the day!

Tuesday we headed to Southern Pines which was referred to as the ole’ VFW course by the locals. This was a more wide open course and after getting beaten up by the Pit, a refreshing “grip it and rip it” course was a welcome site. Same conditions as prior days (fair but playable) and another enjoyable round at a nice course was had. After dinner we sat around the house and watched the Penguins win game 6 and get back in the series!

The closing day was a course that I eagerly anticipated... Tobacco Road. My bro-in-law told me this course will remind me of Royal New Kent in Williamsburg (same designer) and it only took me until the 1st tee box to believe him. Unlike the other tracks, this one was in excellent – I would even say Pristine - shape and I would highly recommend playing it if you get the chance. Many people say this is a “tricked up” course but I really enjoyed the strategy involved in playing here. We were told to make sure we played the correct set of tees to have fun so we played 6000 and had a blast (although I think we could have moved back to 6300). Some lucky shots and “barky’s” led me to an excellent closing 9 – and if I could have made some putts it would have been a career round but it definitely left me with that “can’t wait to get back out there” feeling...you all know what I’m talking about!

Oh yeah and how about those Stanley Cup Champion Penguins! It’s been a good year for Pittsburgh fans so far! Disclaimer... Lefty and Bogeyman are Pittsburgh fans.
