Sadly, our area golf season is about to go into hibernation. With that thought in mind, Bogeyman and Ayce headed for Ocean City, Maryland for one last blast of golf. Waggle's trip was booked through our favorite tour operator, Ocean City Golf Getaway. We stayed at the Holiday Inn on 67th Street and shared the hotel floor with sixty golfers from Pennsylvania. We can recommend

this hotel - nice rooms, good central location, plenty of amenities, free internet, and the staff was great. To round out our threesome, we were joined on our trip by Richmond Ron (Chairman of the Southern Wolf Association) who drove thru Norfolk, the Chesapeake Bay bridge tunnel and up the coast to chase the white ball with Waggle. The weather worked out nicely - temps in the 50s/60 and some sun. Our course selection included The Beach Club, River Run, Lighthouse Sound, and Ocean City Golf Club - Newport Bay. We enjoyed all the courses and in the next few newsletters we will share our reviews. Ocean City is a great golf destination and can be enjoyed year round. Though only 3 hours from Washington & Baltimore, the eastern shore is a bit more temperate in climate because of the surrounding water. Cooler in the summer and warmer in winter means year round golf is a short drive away. Except for Christmas day, the courses are always open, save for the rare snow storm that hits a couple of times each decade. OC may seem deserted in the winter, but think about the great pace of play!

## More Moveable Weights

Since introducing the moveable weight idea to drivers in 2004, Taylor Made has seen several makers ape their innovation. The newest of these will be the Mizuno-600 which will sell for \$399. This driver has a track that runs around the back (opposite the face) of the club where sixteen grams of weight can be positioned to produce fifteen different ball flights. A special tool makes adjusting the weights a 10 second affair so in theory you could fix it before each tee shot. Of course, that would be illegal.
